## The First Aid Kit



## Your Kit should contain:

- 1. Absorbent gauze pads
- 2. Adhesive tape
- 3. Fresh 3% hydrogen peroxide to induce vomiting (do this only when directed by a veterinarian or a poison-control expert)
- 4. Disposable gloves
- 5. Scissors with blunt end
- 6. Tweezers
- 7. OTC antibiotic ointment
- 8. Oral syringe
- 9. Alcohol wipes
- 10. Styptic powder
- 11. An extra leash and collar
- 12. Non-latex disposable gloves
- 13. KY Jelly (to lubricate the thermometer)
- 14. Rectal thermometer (your pet's temperature should not be above 103°F or fall below 100°F)

**Paperwork:** In an emergency situation, you'll want pertinent information in one place: hard copy of medical records, and vaccination records.

**Phone numbers:** The emergency-veterinary clinic, your veterinarian and a poison-control center or hotline (such as the ASPCA poison-control center, which can be reached at 1-800-426-4435).

As a pet owner, you need to make sure to have basic first aid supplies for your pets in your household.
